Buyer Notes

- Nursing homes are moving toward wider beds that are either 39 or 42 inches across, one vendor says. Providers can choose an expandable width built into the bed of the frame that can be used with or without tools.
- Auto contour or cardiac chair positioning is becoming a standard for long-term care bed functionality and resident comfort, one vendor notes. Additionally, pressure reduction mattresses should be considered a standard option for these to help reduce pressure sores and discomfort.
- To ensure product functionality and durability, buy beds in person rather than based merely on catalog descriptions. Look for designs that are maintenance-free and have a longer warranty.
- Consider incorporating color coordination and design to help furniture look more home-like and less institutional.
