**Pricing based on number of people to protect:** Varies by cost, product and service agreement

#### Average price per resident per year:

One-time equipping of doorways can range from about \$500 to more than \$3,000, but much depends on a building's layout and residents. Additional annual costs vary widely.

**Typical delivery time:** Varies from a few days to 6 weeks

**Installation:** Trained installers, either from the seller or the provider, are usually needed. In some cases, facility staff can easily initiate at least parts of a system.

Average life span of product: 7 to 10 years

Average maintenance cost per year: Varies from a few dollars to about \$100
