These eyes never blink

Utah may become the second state that will allow cameras inside residents' rooms; for many operators it's another challenge to keep an eye on

At press time, Utah Gov. Gary Herbert (R) was about to sign legislation requiring assisted living communities to give resident operators in their rooms. The action comes as seven states are making similar action.

While it's not the state of Utah attempts to balance the rights of residents and their desire for safety and security along with legitimate concerns about privacy, and he looks to a new that doesn't just make headlines on headlines, said Rep.
