FROM THE FRONT LINES:

"Will a nurse be able to push a medication cart easily across the carpet, or will he or she have to build up some major muscle to get med pass completed? Often, a hallway may look like an obstacle course: You may have an activity cart, medication cart, linen cart and a dirty linen cart. Throw in carpeting with designs or large patterns and your residents with dementia may become withdrawn or agitated and not want to walk on it."

Buyer Notes

- Evaluate technology when it comes to carpet, such as whether stain-resistant or moisture-wicking features can make it last longer.
- There's a move to contemporary design in carpeting. Many new facilities are choosing lighter colors or modern patterns over more traditional designs. However, memory units must make sure that residents won't misstep with patterns that look like stairs.
- Some experts advise budgeting for daily cleaning and vaccuming in high-traffic areas. One carpet cleaning method is extraction, which involves heated water, sometimes with chemicals, while simultaneously vaccuming the sprayed water and any dissolved dirt.
