FROM THE FRONT LINES:

"Water and other liquids do not go beyond the first layer of an anti-microbial carpet. In addition, the floor covering can be steam-cleaned or vacuumed because we are trying to move away from chemicals to clean. We also went with carpet squares instead of rolled carpeting because if there is a stain or other problems, we won't have to replace the entire rug, just that one spot. Finally, we also set up a mock room with the carpeting that we decided on to make sure it was wheelchair and walker friendly and to see how it performed in reality."

Buyer Notes

- Acoustics are increasingly being recognized as a factor. Carpets that can keep an area quieter, whether it's a hallway or lobby, are more likely to create a calmer and relaxed atmosphere for residents and staff.
- Anti-microbial carpets don't allow water and liquids to go beyond the first layer, making it easier to clean and also preventing smells.
- There's a move toward environmentally friendly, sustainable carpets. Many providers are looking for carpets with fewer volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions.
