Snapshot

Pricing based on number of people to protect: Varies widely depending on technology employed, and on services agreement.

Average price: These are customized projects for vendors. Costs quoted by door, building or campus are possible. Doors can run from \$1,000 to \$5,000.

Pricing Trends 2014-2015: +2% to 3% | 2015-2016: Flat to +2% | 2016-2017: +3%

Typical delivery time: A week or more. In addition, allot for plenty of installation time.

Typical delivery charges:
Usually a part of the sales package

Average life span of product:
10 to 15 years

Power sources:
Battery, electric

Installation: Usually, certified installers are the route to go; some especially tech-savvy staff members might be able to execute what's needed.

Average maintenance costs per year:
Transmitter replacements (\$150 to \$350) and battery replacements are most common costs.

Buyers Notes

- RLTS (real time locating system) technology has been more common in acute-care settings but is making the bridge to LTC more often. Helps with resident security AND staff safety.
- Seek systems that can tell you who is in a certain room —this can be a big factor toward preserving resident safety since certain people should not be together, vendors pointed out.
