Buyer Notes

- Providers should consult vendors and talk with them about the specific linens their facility handles. This can affect the type of machine that should be bought.
- Many providers forget to think about how they will get the dryer into the building. Multiple times, one vendor said, providers haven't realized their doorways are too narrow to fit new machines. Placing them sometimes requires knocking down walls and, subsequently, more expenses.
- Reversing dryers have become more affordable and convenient for the care centers. Benefits include less tangling and wrinkling of sheets, faster drying time and more efficient energy usage.
